MATCH SCHEDULE;

Saturday, 08:00 June 23rd, 2012

INDIVIDUAL FIRED MATCHES 80 Shot Regional Course, Rule 7.15

Match #1: 200yd SF, Target SR, Standing, 2 Sighting shots. 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match #2: 200yd RF, Target SR, Kneeling or Sitting. 2 Sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 60 seconds each.

Contrary to Rule 11.6.7(b). each relay will fire Match #2 immediately following Match #1. Preparation time for sitting rapid fire will begin 2 minutes after completion of that relay's standing string of fire.

Match #3: 300yd RF, Target SR-3, Prone. 2 Sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 70 seconds each.

Match #4: 600yd SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 Sighting shots, 20 Shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match #5: The NRA Regional Championship, Aggregate of Matches #1-#4.

Match #6: Slow Fire aggregate of matches #1 & #4

Match #7: Rapid Fire aggregate of matches #2 & #3

Sunday, 08:00 June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2012

Match #8: CMP SERVICE RIFLE EXCELLENCE-IN-COMPETITION (LEG) MATCH. 50-shot National Match Course; no sighting shots. The “Leg” match is open to any citizen of the United States, 16 years of age or older. The match is governed by the latest CMP Competition Rules. See other part of this program for entry information. Rifles authorized for this match include US rifle cal. .30M1, US rifle cal. 7.62mm M14, and US rifle cal. 5.5mm M16, or their commercial equivalents. Rifles will be in accordance with aforementioned regulations.

Ammunition to be furnished by competitors; 5.56mm used at 600yd must be 69 gr. or heavier.

Classifications are not used in the Excellence-in-Competition matches. Points toward Distinguished Rifleman Designation and Excellence-in-Competition medals will be issued by the CMP in accordance with CMP Regulations.

Fun Match: Concurrently with Rifle Leg Match, for match rifle shooters that wish to shoot the leg match with no sighters.

**EQUIPMENT (Matches #1-#8)**

Rifles must conform to NRA rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2 and 3.3. Competitors must furnish their own ammunition; 5.56mm used at 600 yards must be 69 gr. or heavier (we don't want bullets dropping into the pits).

**AMONG THE COMPETITOR'S DUTIES;**

Competitors are required to be at their assigned points promptly to perform scoring duties and target operation.

**CLASSIFICATION AND CATEGORY;**

NRA classification system will be used. Unclassified competitors will enter Master Class, assigned classification Rule 19.6) may be used or temporary classification (Rule 19.2). Service rifle competitors will compete in service rifle category, all others in match rifle category. In the case of insufficient entries, (see awards schedule) categories will be combined within classes and classes will be combined upward until sufficient entries are attained. Classes will not be combined with High Master. High Master class will shoot for open awards only if there are insufficient entries in that class.

**REGIONAL INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP**

Winner, Second & Third Place NRA Regional Medallions

Each Class and Category: 1<sup>st</sup> (if 3 entries)  
2<sup>nd</sup> (if 8 entries)  
3<sup>rd</sup> (if 13 entries)

Class winners of match #5, without regard for category, will receive Camp Perry Credit worth ½ off NRA Championship fees. 4 credits will be awarded provided minimum entries are met.
