We held an **RO Seminar** in late February. Even after a couple of last minute cancellations we had 27 attendees, which is a very good turnout. Carl Schmidt was our NROI instructor, and it was obvious that the attendees got a lot out of the course. I forgot to take any photos during the classroom portion, but I did take a few on Sunday during the live fire portion – check the website. Thanks, Carl!!

The April, and May **ICORE** matches are cancelled. We're still working on establishing regular **Steel Challenge** match schedule. In the next month or so, we will finalize plans for both matches and post the information on the website.

Some of you may have noticed that the 3 new bays are open just north of Bay 8, by the gravel parking area. We will hydro-seed or something along those lines to stabilize the berms soon. We've also built berms at 100m, 200m, and 300m just to the north of those bays. We will be placing some heavy steel plates out there for practice that can be used for any of the calibers we normally shoot.

The new bays will be awesome! All the shooting disciplines who share the Club's action shooting facilities will profit from this expansion. More options for stages, the ability to run events concurrently, a little more 'reach out and touch' than we've had before...

Important Reminder: We continue to have cases where equipment is being abused and/or not put away. The steel used by the cowboy action shooters is NOT to be used for IPSC or jacketed rounds. There is plenty of approved steel props available, and we need to be respectful of each other's rules and restrictions. Also, please put props away when you are done and keep the ranges clear and neat. Better for us all.....
