For eleven years we have hosted the largest women's instructional shooting clinic in the nation and it would not be possible without our dedicated members.

Winter Skeet League

Our Winter league for 2011 will start on 21 November 2010. We are shooting a shorter league this year in the hope that we can finish before the really cold and wet weather hits us. If you are interested in a little friendly competition come on out. Buck Sifford will again be handling the squadding and the sign up, so let him know if you want to shoot. Novice shooters are welcome, we have some excellent shooters who are always willing to give advice when asked.

The league will shoot on Sunday afternoon at 1300 hours (1 pm). Again, we will be having 2 leagues at the same time. We will shoot a doubles league and a regular skeet league. You can shoot either or both. We shoot 50 targets (two rounds) per week for 6 weeks for a total of 300 targets. The cost is \$35.00 for one league or \$65.00 for both leagues. This covers the cost of 12 rounds of skeet and some league medals at the end of the league(s). As always this is a duel league, both scratch and handicap. The handicap portion is set up so that a steadily improving shooter has an excellent chance of winning the top spot.

All shooters will be assigned to a team of 4 or 5 shooters depending upon how many sign up for the league. Each team will compete weekly against another team and will be assigned points depending upon how well they shoot that week. The highest point team at the end of the 6 weeks will be our league champions.

OUTDOOR NRA REVOLVER PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP

Oklahoma Rifle Association - - Oklahoma City Gun Club

Eleven Oklahoma competitors and one Kansas competitor came to the firing line to compete in the Outdoor Service Pistol State Championship. Following completion of the Service Pistol State Championship, seven Oklahomans and two Texans came to the firing line on Saturday afternoon to compete in the Outdoor NRA Revolver State Pistol Championship. Both championships consisted of a 90-round Aggregate match of 20 rounds Slow Fire at 50 yards, a 30 round National Match Course (10 rounds Slow Fire at 50 yards, 10 rounds Timed Fire at 25 yards, and 10 rounds Rapid Fire at 25 yards), a 20 round Timed Fire Match at 25 yards, and a 20 round Rapid Fire Match at 25 yards. A 30-round Civilian Marksmanship Program Excellence-in-Competition Leg Match was held in conjunction with the Service Pistol State Championship; additionally, a 30-round NRA Distinguished Revolver Match was held in conjunction with the Revolver State Pistol Championship.

In the Service Pistol State Championship, Richard W. Chadwick, of Davis, OK shot an aggregate score of 824-16 to win the Oklahoma Rifle Association State Championship Match Winner Trophy and the High Oklahoma Resident Trophy Plaque; he additionally won the Slow Fire and National Match Course matches. With a win in the Timed Fire match, Charles W. Abston of Jones, OK took First Place in the Master Class with a score of 816-18. Also a Master Class shooter, Darrell L. Brooks, Sr. of Washington, OK won the High Grand Senior Trophy with a score of 797-10. Larry Kent Stonecipher of Ada, OK took First Place Expert in every individual match winning the Expert Class with a score of 806-14. With a win in the Rapid Fire match and First Place Sharpshooter in every other individual match, Darrell L. Brooks, Jr. took First Place in the combined Sharpshooter/Marksmanship Class with a score of 807-13.

In the Civilian Marksmanship Program Excellence-in-Competition Service Pistol "Leg" Match a trio of Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge holders competed for placement among the top three positions. Charles W. Abston of Jones, OK shot a score of 271-2 for the First Place Blue Ribbon and a CMP Pin; Ronald L. Doggett of Oklahoma City, OK fired a score of 269-6 for the Second Place Red Ribbon and a CMP Pin; and Darrell L. Brooks, Jr. of Washington, OK took the Third Place White Ribbon and a CMP Pin with a score of 266-3. In fourth place overall and first amongst the Non-Distinguished competitors was Richard L. Wise of Yukon, OK. Richard fired a score of 259-1 and earned another 6 points toward the 30 that are required for the award of the Distinguished Pistol Shoot Badge.

Continuing his winning ways from the Service Pistol State Championship and with wins in the Slow Fire, National Match Course and Timed Fire matches, Richard W. Chadwick of Davis, OK shot an aggregate score of 806-18 in the Revolver State Pistol Championship and won the Oklahoma Rifle Association State Championship Match Winner Trophy and the High Oklahoma Resident Trophy Plaque. With a win in the Rapid Fire match, Darrell L. Brooks, Sr. of Washington, OK was also the aggregate winner in the combined Master/Expert class with a score of 768-10. Darrell L. Brooks, Jr., also of Washington, OK, took First Place Sharpshooter in every individual match winning the combined Sharpshooter/Marksmanship class with a score of 782-12.

In the NRA Distinguished Revolver Match, Darrell L. Brooks, Jr. shot a score of 279-10 for the First Place Blue Ribbon and a Revolver Pin; his performance earned him 6 points toward the NRA Distinguished Revolver Badge. Richard W. Chadwick fired a score of 279-8 for the Second Place Red Ribbon and a Revolver Pin. Firing a score of 258-4, Prescott W. Smith of Terrell, TX took the Third Place White Ribbon and a Revolver Pin.

Nelson O. Wood of Edmond, OK and Janice M. Meloy of Noble, OK served as Chief Range Officer and Chief Statistical Officer, respectively. The following OKC Gun Club members served as Line Safety Officers and Match Workers: Terese Booth, Dan Froehlich, Dennis Gleason, Bruce Heng, John Semands, Lew Tait, and Salli Wandke. Competitors and match workers received a complementary 10% discount on their lunches from the Subway Sandwich Shop in Arcadia, OK; additionally, each competitor and match worker received a souvenir from the Oklahoma Rifle Association.
